Project Outline:

We are excited to announced that the project was awarded to Tonda Construction Limited at a total cost of \$9,057,741.00 including HST. The Township has received a grant of approximately \$5.5 million dollars from the Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program Community Culture and Recreational Stream for funding. The remaining cost will be funded by Township reserves, a fundraising campaign and a long-term loan. Over the past number of years, Council has been dedicating reserve funds through the budget process in planning for future renovations of the Community Centre. The Campaign Committee has been established to develop a plan for securing and recognizing donations as well as fundraising activities.

Renovation Snapshot:

- A new enhanced accessible entrance that will be more spacious and welcoming with glass panels which will lead visitors to a lobby/gathering area. This entrance will be located at the east side of the Community Centre.
- Elevator access to new seating/viewing area
- Expansion of south side dressing rooms
- Accessible dressing rooms which will act as change spaces for the pool
- Additional multi-purpose community hall with dividing wall for adaptability
- Improved/more bathrooms
- Additional parking
- Tennis courts will be moved to Spencer Ave Park and take shape as a new multipurpose court
