NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

THE PROJECT: The Township of Lucan Biddulph has undertaken an Urban Servicing Master Plan for the community of Lucan. The Master Plan reviewed existing infrastructure for water treatment, storage, and supply; sanitary sewage collection and treatment; and stormwater management within the current urban boundary of Lucan. It also included an examination of future needs as the community continues to grow and develop. The Plan will serve as a strategic document for the continued provision of water, wastewater and stormwater services, and provide a timeline for implementation of identified upgrades, expansions and modifications to existing infrastructure.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PROCESS: The Urban Servicing Master Plan was conducted in accordance with the requirements of Approach 2 for Master Plans under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA), dated October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015. Following the completion of this Master Plan, the Township may proceed with the implementation of the pre-approved Schedule A and A+ projects. Schedule B and C projects will require additional study to fulfill MCEA requirements prior to implementation. The following projects are the preferred servicing solutions:

Requests on other grounds will not be considered. Requests should include the requester contact information and full name. Requests should specify what kind of order is being requested (request for conditions or a request for an individual/comprehensive environmental assessment), how an order may prevent, mitigate or remedy potential adverse impacts on Aboriginal and treaty rights and any information in support of the statements in the request.
