



Project Timeline









DRAFT Recommendations

Lucan Biddulph Parks and Recreation Master Plan



General Findings

Lucan Biddulph CMC

- Expansion and renewals at the Lucan Biddulph Community Memorial Centre positions it to meet many needs over the next 10 years.

Programs

- Entry into selected programming has filled certain gaps and reinforces the overall community development model.

New Parks

- Additions of the Campanelle Park Soccer Complex and Spencer Park have helped parkland service levels keep pace with growth.

Ice Time

- Concerns about limited ice time have been confirmed and future projections suggest Lucan Biddulph could require between one and two ice pads.

Future Subdivisions

- Planned residential areas will generate needs for recreation services, parkland and trail connections.

Parks & Recreation

Lucan Biddulph CMC

- Determine the architectural feasibility and costs of twinning the arena, modernizing dressing rooms and improving the gymnasium.
- Add a lit ball diamond by relocating the undersized diamond from Elm Street Park.

Market Street Park

- Assess the costs of repairing and modernizing Lucan Scout Guide Hall to determine a future course of action for the building.

Campanelle Park

- Integrate washrooms, storage and a playground.

Granton Park

- Carry out ball diamond surface improvements.
- Rejuvenate the tennis/pickleball court and explore the ability to create a dedicated half basketball court.

Service Delivery

- Prepare **allocation policies** for arenas and sports fields in consultation with users.
- Prepare a **Pricing Policy** and **User Fee Review** for parks and recreation services.
- Pursue a **Youth-Friendly Community designation** and explore Leader in Training (LIT) opportunities to build capacity of local youth and teens.

Trails

- Explore development of a **trail loop** using connections between the Ridge Crossing Trail / Soccer Complex, Township-owned lands located north of Fallon Drive, and future residential areas located east of Saintsbury Line.
