




Q6 If the Township were to maintain the same tax rate, what area do you NOT want to be affected by service reduction?


Q7 If the Township needs to increase the amount of revenue it collects from citizens to offset risings costs, how would you prefer that this be accomplished?




Q9 How would you rate the value of your tax dollar?




