## NEW! Carbon Monoxide Legislation

As of January 1, 2026, the Ontario Fire Code is requiring the installation of additional carbon monoxide alarms, regardless of building age. This new legislation also applies to residential occupancies, residential suites and care occupancies served by a forced-air fuel-burning appliance not contained within the building.

### What's Changing?

CO alarms will now be mandatory on every storey of all homes with a fuel-burning appliance, fireplace, or attached garage. Battery operated and plug-in carbon monoxide alarms are permitted.

### Why It Matters:

Carbon monoxide is a silent killer—colourless, odourless, and deadly. These updated rules are designed to keep families safe and save lives.
