As per the COVID-19 Provincial Testing Guidance Update, please only visit the Mobile Testing Site to seek COVID-19 testing if you:

*Have COVID-19 symptoms;

*Have been exposed to a confirmed case of COVID-19, as informed by the Health Unit or through an exposure notification from the COVID Alert app;

*Are a resident or work in a setting that has a COVID-19 outbreak, as identified and informed by the Health Unit;

*Are eligible for testing as part of a targeted testing initiative directed by the Ministry of Health or Health Unit

*Require a test for surgery or to visit a loved one in a long term care setting

*Require a test to return to school/ daycare/work

- This mobile testing unit is available to Lucan Biddulph and non-Lucan Biddulph residents that meet the above testing requirements.
- Please continue to follow proper protocols for facemasks, handwashing/santiizing and practice physical distancing when attending the Mobile Testing Unit.
- Please bring your health card or proof of health coverage. Those without health coverage can still be seen.
